What is Groundhog Job Shadow Day?

Job Shadow Day is a one day event during which students are provided an opportunity to participate in job shadowing experiences directly in the workplace. The goal is to provide students an up-close look at what a “real job” is like and how the skills they learn in school are put to use in the workplace.

How will Groundhog Job Shadow work?

Pre-event:

Junior Achievement will assign participating schools to your company site, coordinate with schools to arrange transportation and provide student, teacher and JSD company coordinators with guide book materials.

Day of Event:

Students arrive at company site and after attending a welcoming and brief company overview, they then spend time with their assigned volunteer

Post Event:

Complete the Job Shadow Post event Evaluation Forms and return all required documentation to the JA Coordinator.
